Anurag Jain Sir started by explaining what drugs are and the different types of drugs that are commonly used, with real-life examples. He gave detailed information about how addiction develops in the early stages and also described the signs and symptoms of drug addiction, which helped the students to identify these indicators. He highlighted the role of community vigilance in fighting drug addiction, discussed the NDPS Act-1985 and its legal implications, and highlighted the importance of alerting the authorities and concerned family members about anyone who resorts to drug use.

Dr. Mosam Firke discussed how drug use negatively affects the life of an addict, highlighting the serious consequences on physical and emotional health. He gave detailed information about how drug addiction can have a detrimental impact on a person's future, including personal, professional and academic problems.
