## Report on Community Pharmacy Visit

### “Medplus Pharmacy (Optival Health Solution Private Limited), Hinganghat”

Tulaskar College of Pharmacy, Hinganghat organized a **field visit to Medplus Pharmacy (Optival Health Solution Private Limited), Hinganghat, District Wardha – 442301** on **10th January 2026** for **Second Year D. Pharm students**. The visit was organized by **Mr. Pradeep S. Raghatate, Head of Department (Diploma in Pharmacy)** as a part of experiential learning under the community pharmacy curriculum.

A total of **55 students** participated in the visit along with faculty members **Mr. Pranay Burle, Mr. Parag Bhaimare, and Miss Monika Bhojar**. The visit commenced at **12.45 p.m.** and concluded at **2.00 p.m.** To ensure effective learning, students were divided into **two groups** during the visit.

During the visit, students were introduced to the **design and layout of a community pharmacy**, highlighting proper arrangement of medicines and patient service areas. The pharmacist explained the **storage conditions of medicines**, including temperature control, segregation of drugs, and stock management principles such as FIFO and FEFO.

Students also observed **patient counselling practices**, where the importance of correct drug usage, dosage instructions, and ethical communication was emphasized. The process of **prescription handling** and legal aspects related to dispensing of medicines were explained in detail.

The pharmacy staff demonstrated **billing procedures, bookkeeping, and documentation**, along with **purchase and inventory control systems** used to maintain stock efficiently. Students were also informed about the **disposal of expired and damaged medicines** following regulatory guidelines.

Additionally, students gained exposure to **pharmacy management software**, which is used for billing, inventory tracking, and record maintenance. The pharmacist also explained the **regulatory requirements** applicable to community pharmacies under the Drug and Cosmetics Act and Rules.

Overall, the field visit was **informative and beneficial**, providing students with practical insight into the daily operations of a community pharmacy. The visit helped bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and real-world pharmacy practice, thereby enhancing the professional competence of D. Pharm students.
